## Item 2.01 Completion of Acquisition or Disposition of Assets.

On March 30, 2012, Prestige Brands Holdings, Inc. (the "Company") completed its previously announced acquisition of the Debrox<sup>®</sup> and Gly-Oxide<sup>®</sup> over-the-counter (OTC) pharmaceutical brands sold in North America, including certain related contracts, trademarks and inventory (the "Assets"), from GlaxoSmithKline plc and certain of its affiliates (collectively, "GSK") pursuant to the business sale and purchase agreement dated as of December 20, 2011 (the "Purchase Agreement") by and among the Company and GSK. A copy of the Purchase Agreement was filed as Exhibit 2.2 to the Company's Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") on December 27, 2011, and is incorporated herein by reference. The purchase price for the Assets was \$45 million in cash, subject to a post-closing inventory adjustment to be determined. The purchase price was funded by cash provided by the issuance of senior secured debt under the Company's \$660 million New Term Loan Facility and the issuance of \$250 million in Senior Notes, which were discussed in Item 1.01 of the Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the Commission on February 2, 2012 and is incorporated herein by reference. The completion of the acquisition of the Assets completes the Company's acquisition from GSK of a total of 17 OTC pharmaceutical brands sold in North America. The Company's acquisition of 15 OTC pharmaceutical brands from GSK was completed on January 31, 2012, which was further discussed in Item 2.01 of the Company's Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the Commission on February 2, 2012 and is incorporated herein by reference.

## Prestige Brands Holdings, Inc. Completes Purchase of Debrox® and Gly-Oxide® from GSK Finalizing 17 Brand Transaction

IRVINGTON, NY,--(BUSINESS WIRE)--April 2, 2012--Prestige Brands Holdings, Inc. (NYSE-PBH) today announced that it has completed the purchase of the two remaining brands of the seventeen brands it agreed to acquire from GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) on December 20, 2011. Friday's purchase of Debrox<sup>®</sup> ear wax remover and Gly-Oxide<sup>®</sup> oral rinse completes the transaction.

The purchase of fifteen of the seventeen brands Prestige agreed to acquire was completed on January 31, 2012 for \$615 million. The subsequent purchase of the remaining two brands finalizes the transaction, which called for Prestige to pay a total of \$660 million in cash plus a customary post-closing inventory adjustment under the original terms of the agreements.

Sawaya Segalas & Company, Inc. LLC acted as exclusive financial advisor to Prestige Brands in these transactions.

Prestige Brands markets and distributes brand name over-the-counter and household cleaning products throughout the U.S., Canada and certain international markets. The Company's core brands include Chloraseptic<sup>®</sup> sore throat treatments, Clear Eyes<sup>®</sup> eye care products, Compound W<sup>®</sup> wart removers, The Doctor's<sup>®</sup> NightGuard<sup>®</sup> dental protector, the Little Remedies<sup>®</sup> and PediaCare<sup>®</sup> lines of pediatric over-the-counter products, Efferdent<sup>®</sup> denture care products, Luden's<sup>®</sup> throat drops, Dramamine<sup>®</sup> motion sickness treatment, BC<sup>®</sup> & Goody's<sup>®</sup> headache powders, Fiber Choice<sup>®</sup> and Beano<sup>®</sup> digestive aids, Debrox<sup>®</sup> ear wax remover, and Comet<sup>®</sup> household cleaners.
